1. Students enrolled in the St Mary's College Instrumental Music program attend a half hour group lesson once a week. Lesson groups and sizes are subject to change at all times and are adjusted at the teacher's discretion.

2. Students will receive 32 lessons per annum. Refunds will only be given at the end of the year to those students who have not received 32 lessons. Students who withdraw during the year will not receive any refund regardless of their lesson total.

All fees are billed (as applicable to individual student) per school term. Details below:

Billable lessons include –

- (a) Student receives lesson as normal. Please note the day/time of lesson is subject to change. Parents will be informed through practice diary and or email notification.
- (b) Student forgets their lesson time or instrument
- (c) Student is absent from school (if absence is prolonged, please contact the Instrumental Music Coordinator)
- (d) Staff Professional Development days
- (e) School activity days including camp, excursions, carnivals or competitions

Students will be billed for any lesson where the teacher is available at the school to teach on their lesson day. Public holidays and lessons missed due to teacher absence (including illness, special leave or other events) will not be charged for.

3. Teachers will attempt to reschedule lessons if they have been missed due to teacher absence. This is not always possible and in some cases student groups will be adjusted to accommodate the extra lessons. Lessons will not be rescheduled if a student forgets their instrument or lesson time.
4. The College will not provide refunds to families who decide to discontinue instrumental lessons during a term. If a student wishes to discontinue lessons, written notice emailed to kjepson@cns.catholic.edu.au is required at least 4 weeks prior to the end of a term. Failure to meet this deadline will result in another term fee being payable.
5. All students enrolled in the College's Instrumental Music Program are committed to a FULL TERM of lessons. Fees are invoiced by the College on a term basis and are payable in advance.
